- Develop a streamlined, business-friendly, online permitting system: Our pledge is a first step in a larger
 effort to streamline, simplify, and bring online those regulatory requirements that have traditionally been
 fragmented across multiple agencies and handled through a paper-based process. Our ultimate goal is for
 small business owners to be able to manage and complete most of their regulatory obligations within a
 single easy-to-use online system.
- 3. Share best practices: In an effort to encourage other municipalities to join us in this effort, we are joining a community of practice administered by the National League of Cities, and commit to sharing best practices, publicizing key learnings, highlighting tangible outcomes, supporting smart regulatory simplification, and providing visibility into our actions."





Q2 How much commercial space do you occupy?



Q3 Do you lease or own your property?





Q9 Is the City embracing redevelopment or new construction to attract business and residents?



Q10 Is the City doing enough to connect the industrial areas to the economic base of the City by incorporating shared space, live/work and alternative retail space?






