


Educational Attainment



Englewood offers some of the finest recreational opportunities in the region. Englewood has excellent parks and recreation amenities that enable residents to enjoy the outdoors close to home.

Englewood's Recreation Center, Broken Tee Englewood golf course, Malley Senior Recreation Center and aquatics programs have received numerous awards. 
