11-3-2: Removal of Ice and Snow

- A. It shall be unlawful for any owner, tenant, lessee or occupant of any lot, block or parcel of real estate within the City, or for any agent in charge of such property, to allow any snow or ice to accumulate or remain upon any sidewalk contiguous to such property for longer than twelve (12) hours from the time of the last accretion of such snow or ice.
- B. It shall be unlawful for any person to remove or cause to be removed any snow or ice from privately owned property within the City and place or cause to be placed such snow or ice upon any street or alley within the City.
- C. Exception snow or ice on sidewalks abutting City streets may be placed in the City street. If such snow or ice is removed into the traveled portion of any street, such snow and ice shall be spread over the surface of such street in such manner as to cause the least interference to traffic and drainage upon said street.
