**OCCUPANCY
STORAGE CONTAINER/DUMPSTER APPLICATION
GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**

A Right of Way Occupancy Permit is required prior to placement of any container within the Right-of-Way and the permit must be visible on the property. The issued permit authorizes occupancy on the public right-of-way for only the date, time, location and activity as designated on the permit.

DUMPSTERS

1. Dumpster must be placed in front of the permitted property.
2. Proper traffic control devices shall be maintained through the duration of the permit.
3. Must have a 36 inch reflective cone placed on the corner street side of the container.
4. Containers must be placed and fit within a parking lane and be a minimum of 20 feet from any corner, alley, or entrance. At no time can a container occupy or impede a sidewalk, travel lane, no parking zone or alley.
5. Dumpsters/containers may be placed in the public Right-of-Way for a maximum of 180 days in a 12 month period.
6. All dumpsters/containers placed within the Right-of-Way are subject to inspection by City Inspectors.

STORAGE CONTAINERS

1. Container must be placed in front of the permitted property.
2. Proper traffic control devices shall be maintained through the duration of the permit.
3. Must have a 36 inch reflective cone placed on the corner street side of the container.
4. Containers must be placed and fit within a parking lane and be a minimum of 20 feet from any corner, alley, or entrance. At no time can a container occupy or impede a sidewalk, travel lane, no parking zone or alley.
5. Dumpsters/containers may be placed in the public Right-of-Way for a maximum of 180 days in a 12 month period.
6. All dumpsters/containers placed within the Right-of-Way are subject to inspection by City Inspectors.
