## OCCUPANCY STORAGE CONTAINER/DUMPSTER APPLICATION GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

A Right of Way Occupancy Permit is required prior to placement of any container within the Right-of-Way and the permit must be visible on the property. The issued permit authorizes occupancy on the public right-of-way for only the date, time, location and activity as designated on the permit.

## **DUMPSTERS**

- 1. Dumpster must be placed in front of the permitted property.
- 2. Proper traffic control devices shall be maintained through the duration of the permit.
- 3. Must have a 36 inch reflective cone placed on the corner street side of the container.
- 4. Containers must be placed and fit within a parking lane and be a minimum of 20 feet from any corner, alley, or entrance. At no time can a container occupy or impede a sidewalk, travel lane, no parking zone or alley.
- 5. Dumpsters/containers may be placed in the public Right-of-Way for a maximum of 180 days in a 12 month period.
- 6. All dumpsters/containers placed within the Right-of-Way are subject to inspection by City Inspectors.

## **STORAGE CONTAINERS**

- 1. Container must be placed in front of the permitted property.
- 2. Proper traffic control devices shall be maintained through the duration of the permit.
- 3. Must have a 36 inch reflective cone placed on the corner street side of the container.
- 4. Containers must be placed and fit within a parking lane and be a minimum of 20 feet from any corner, alley, or entrance. At no time can a container occupy or impede a sidewalk, travel lane, no parking zone or alley.
- 5. Dumpsters/containers may be placed in the public Right-of-Way for a maximum of 180 days in a 12 month period.
- 6. All dumpsters/containers placed within the Right-of-Way are subject to inspection by City Inspectors.
