## STANDING JUDICIAL ORDER: ENTRY REQUIREMENTS OF PUBLIC DUE TO COVID-19 PANDEMIC

Pursuant to Section 13-10-112, C.R.S., this Court hereby adopts the following rules to preserve the health and safety of both the public and court personnel in coordination with suggested CDC, State, County and Local Guidelines as related to the Covid-19 Pandemic:

- Anyone who is sick, has a fever of 100.4 or more, coughing, is short of breath or has been in recent contact with someone with Covid-19, is not permitted to enter the court area. Accommodations will be made to ensure due process rights to anyone denied entry.
- Persons 65 or over and/or have a compromising health risk factor will have arrangements made to safely handle your case.
- Persons must wash hands/use hand sanitizer before entering the court area.
- All persons will be required to wear a face covering.
- Social distancing requirements of 6 to 10 feet are mandated.
- Do not approach any person or touch any object unless instructed to do so.
- Only the defendant, defendant's attorney, legal guardian, victim or witness scheduled with an actual court date or appointment will be permitted to access the court area.
- Only 10 persons, including court staff, will be permitted in any one gathering area at a time. Persons may be required to wait in an exterior or outside area.
- Only 2 persons at a time are allowed at the clerk's window.
- Persons may be subject to a temperature check prior to being permitted to enter the court area.
- Failure to adhere to these requirements may result in removal from the area.

This Standing Judicial Order will be a valid Order beginning May 11, 2020 and remain in effect until further Court Order.
