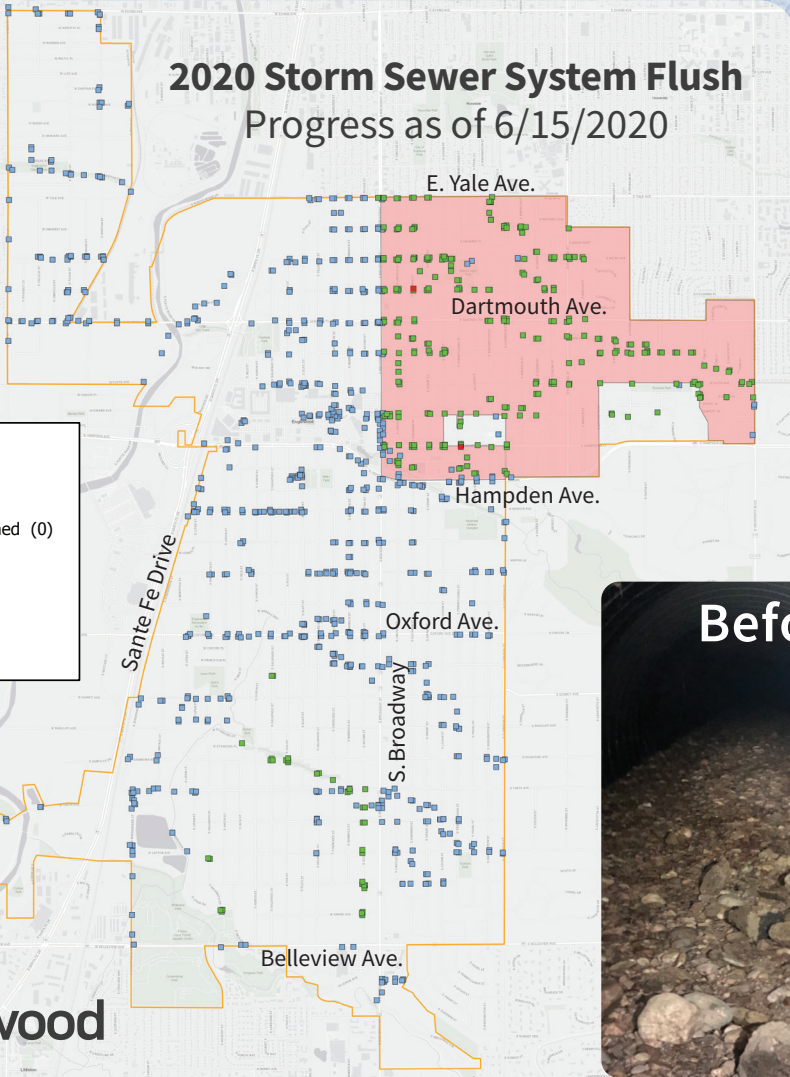

250 storm sewer inlets/pipes have been cleaned since December, resulting in 63,500 pounds of debris removed.

Thanks to increased investment by residents as authorized by the Englewood City Council, the City has been able to clean 250 storm sewer inlets/pipes since December 16, 2019. This has resulted in 63,500 pounds of rock, sediment and debris removed from our pipes so they can carry more water during a rain storm.

Additional revenue from fees will also allow the City to sell \$35 million in bonds to replace several miles of undersized, deteriorating storm drainage pipe in south Englewood to prevent flooding.
