Arapahoe Weatherization Assistance Program

## A COMPARISON

Offers grants to low and moderate income Englewood homeowners for energy efficiency related projects. The grants are up to a **maximum of \$8,000 per household** for energy efficiency upgrades as determined by an energy audit.

Free Energy Audit; however, implementation of desired energy efficiency projects **NOT free**.

### PROJECT TYPE EXAMPLES

Energy audit, furnace and water heater safety test, furnace replacement (if eligible), solar panels (if eligible), insulation in attics, walls, and crawl spaces, storm windows (if eligible) sealing air leaks, LED light bulbs.

### ELIGIBLE TO RENTERS?

For rental properties, landlords must agree to participate in the program. Mobile homes also eligible.
