

• Parks, Recreation, Library and Golf

- Library winter reading starts January 8th for adults and young adults (age 16 and up). Prizes will be awarded. Sign up in person at the library starting on January 8th. The program ends on February 16th.
- Englewood Public Library is now fine free! You will no longer be charged fines on overdue items for most collections. Fine free items includes all books, audiobooks, DVDs/Blu-rays, children's music CD's, and LaunchPads. Items such as video games, book club kits, board games, and state park backpacks will still carry late fees. Patrons will still be held accountable for the cost of lost or damaged materials.

- The Recreation Center had a 17% increase in visits in 2023 over 2022 and Malley had a 12.5% increase in the same time frame.

Utilities
