The evening typically consists of neighbors coming together and throwing a block party, where police and city officials can join in on the fun. Englewood will provide free barricades to ensure your street is closed safely.

Registration Deadline: Wednesday, July 31

THE APPLICATION FEE FOR THE BLOCK PARTY PERMIT IS \$25 and will be waived for NATIONAL NIGHT OUT PARTICIPANTS. REQUIRED BARRICADES WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE CITY AT NO COST FOR NATIONAL NIGHT OUT PARTICIPANTS.

Online Permitting Now Available

The City of Englewood is now utilizing a new software system that allows for electronic submittal of your Block Party application. The System provides for online payments, thus eliminating the need for phone payments or office visits.

To submit your application:

Create your secure account at: ims.englewoodco.gov, to submit required documents, receive notifications throughout the review process, make online payments, and communicate with staff. After the review of the application is complete, Public Works IMS will contact you to let you know that your application has been approved. Once approved, you will receive an email containing a link to pay for your permit and get your permit issued.



	1. The issued permit is pursuant to 20-11 of the Model Traffic Code Colorado Municipalities.			
	2. The parade will proceed only as designated on the issued permit			
	3. No deviation from the prescribed route will be made without the approval of the Director of Public Works.			
SPE	ECIAL EVENT/BLOCK PARTY			
1.	Application for a Special Event or Block Party in the public right of way shall include map/drawing showing the location of the party and the placement of traffic control devices.			
2.	. Per City Council Resolution No. 36, Series of 2019, the application fee for the Block Party permit is \$25.00 and IS NON-REFUNDABLE.			
3.	3. The responsible party shall provide the required number and type of barricades for safely closing a public street to vehicular traffic as shown on the attached drawing. The applicant is encouraged to work with a barricade rental company for the set-up and removal of the barricades.			
4.	A confirmation showing rental and scheduled delivery of the barricades is required prior to approval of the block party permit.			
5.	Barricades shall be placed no earlier than 9:00 am on the day of the party and then removed from the street before 8:30 pm. Nothing shall be attached to the barricades.			
6.	The responsible party shall notify adjacent property owners of street closure a minimum of 24 hours prior to the event.			
7.	The responsible party will maintain reasonable control over the conduct of the guests.			
8.	. It is unlawful for any person to drink or have in their possession or under their control in any public place any intoxicating liquor in any container of any kind or description which is not sealed or on which the seal is broken. 5-3C-3 (A), 2000 E.M.C. Provided, however, that nothing in this section will permit anyone under the age of eighteen years to have in his possession any intoxicating liquor of any kind in any manner whatsoever.			
9.	No apparatus can be set up in the street. An access lane shall be provided at all times for authorized emergency vehicles.			
10.	No change in permitted activity shall be made without the prior approval of the City of Englewood.






