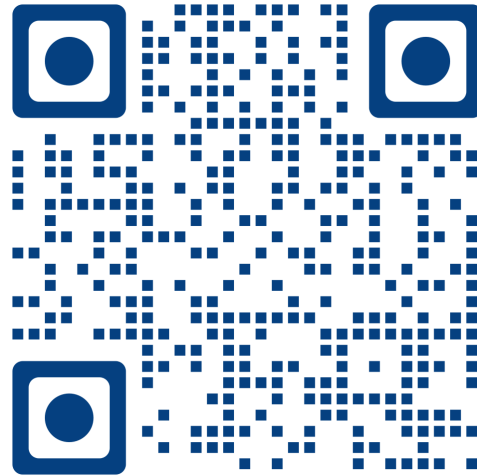
Water Meter Upgrades

How to schedule and what to expect

Hello Englewood Utility Customer,

The City of Englewood is upgrading its water metering system to serve you better, starting **June 18, 2024**. We're installing Advanced Metering Infrastructure technology for more accurate billing and monitoring throughout the city. Advanced Metering Infrastructure allows remote data collection to detect leaks and improve service.

You are receiving this letter as your water meter is located inside of your property. We kindly ask you to visit englewood.fieldmanagementsystems.com or **scan the QR code to the right** to schedule the new meter install.



D&B Construction is the contractor for this project, and they will need access to the water meter inside of your residence.

Their team will be clearly identifiable with uniforms and city badges. D&B Construction has very strict safety protocols. The process takes roughly 30 minutes once the meter is located. You will experience a short, temporary water interruption during the changeout. Installation technicians will be wearing the badge to the right to show their association with the City of Englewood.
