

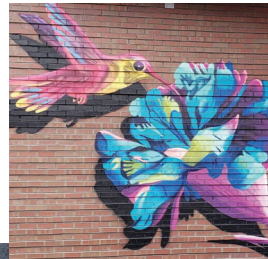
Welcome To The Pop!

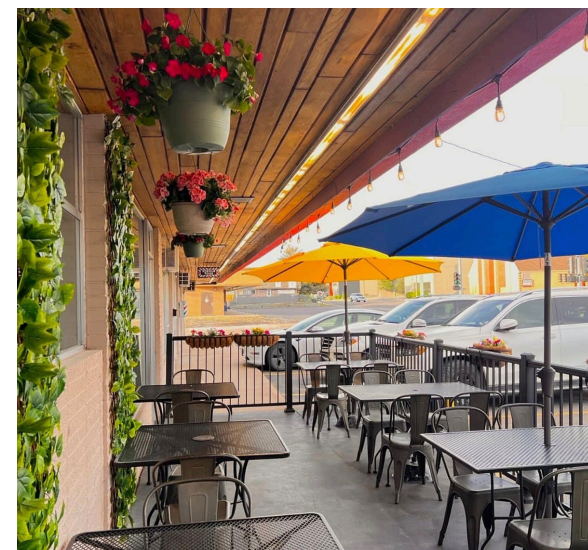
New Restaurants on Future Festival Street
