#### South Englewood Flood Reduction Update



Englewood Public Works and contractor ACC are using advanced tunneling technology to mitigate flood risks while minimizing disruptions. The Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) will excavate a 1,600-foot tunnel between the new detention ponds, near Radcliff Avenue and Navajo Street, and Rotolo Park. Utilizing the TBM will reduce impact to residents along Stanford Avenue.

# Is your home eligible for a historical landmark designation?

Qualification, nomination and application info

Options available for local landmark designations of individual historic properties or multi-property historic districts through the Historic Preservation Commission (HPC).

#### **Designation process:**

- 1. Staff receipt and review of application
- 2. Historic Preservation Commission public hearing
- 3. HPC makes recommendation to city council
- 4. City council public hearing and a final determination is made
- 5. Recordation of historical landmark status
