The **FREE bert** shuttle provides convenient access between the CityCenter light rail station, downtown and the Craig Hospital/Swedish Medical Center area.

The shuttle began in 2004 as a project to demonstrate how transit can reduce congestion on our streets and help improve air quality. In 2024, the shuttle was renamed **bert** from The Englewood Trolley, and underwent a redesign that included new shuttles, branding, stop signs and expanded hours.

Roughly 14,000 riders enjoy the shuttle each month.

rules

To keep the shuttle clean & reliable, we ask passengers to follow these simple rules:

- Smoking/vaping is prohibited on the shuttle
- Shirt and shoes are required
- No food is allowed on the shuttle
- Drinks must be in a plastic, non-disposable cup
- No weapons, firearms, dangerous or flammable materials
- Disruptive passengers may be asked to exit the shuttle at the driver's discretion
